Prospective Bidders should possess a valid PCAB License applicable to the contract and have completed contract with a value of at least 50% of the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC). The prospective bidders must also have key personnel and equipment (Listed in the Eligibility Forms) available for the prosecution of the contract. The BAC will use non-discretionary pass/fail criteria in the Preliminary Examination of Bids and will conduct post-qualification of the Lowest Calculated Bid.

All particulars relative to Eligibility Documents and Screening, Bid Security, Performance Security, Pre-Bidding Conference(s), Evaluation of Bids, Post-Qualification and Award of Contract shall be governed by pertinent provisions of New Government Procurement Act (NGPA) R.A. 12009 and its Implementing Rules and Regulations.
